

NICHOLAS BURGESS

It is with great sadness that we record the death of a former student, Nick Burgess, who tragically died in his sleep in his Hall of Residence at University in February 2007. He left the school in 2004, commenced a Law course at University and then went on to change direction in his career, taking further Science A Levels and gaining a place to study Medicine at Barts and The London School of Medicine & Dentistry. He was delighted to be studying to become a doctor, and to be able to represent Barts and the London at rugby. His funeral took place on Tuesday 13th March and Mr Bishop and Mrs Wiltshire represented the school. His medical school also held a Memorial Concert for Nick in June, at which many of his friends performed, and which was a most moving celebration of his life. The Nicholas Burgess Memorial Elective Scholarship has been founded in Nick's memory, which will provide funding to assist a medical student of Barts and the London to study diabetes on elective.
