### **KEGS STUDENTS CELEBRATE OUTSTANDING A LEVEL RESULTS:**

Students at King Edward VI Grammar School in Chelmsford, Essex, received exciting news of their examination success today. The overall results are excellent, with an overall points score of 508 (where an A =120) placing us safely in the top ten of schools in the country by the measure that, we feel, provides the best overall indicator of our students' success. We are thrilled that the students' dedication and hard work and the exceptionally high quality of teaching have been reflected in our examination results. We are particularly proud that our students are able to achieve a very high level of success across a broad range of subjects, in addition to a very full programme of activities beyond the classroom, with the vast majority securing their first choice university places in a highly competitive market.

With 85.1% of grades at A-B, this is our second best set of A Level results on record by this measure and not far off our best set ever. Students who achieved exceptional results were Maxwell Spence, our School Captain, who gained 7 A's at A Level, and Chirag Patel and Christopher Bridge who both achieved 6 A's. In addition, 20 other students gained 5 A grades and a further 31 students gained 4 A grades. Oliver Monro was judged by AQA to be their best Humanities student nationally (out of 53900 entries) at A Level this year; he will be invited to special ceremony in December where he will receive a silver medal in recognition of his outstanding achievement.
